The Accounting and Financial Reporting Council (**AFRC**) welcomes the measures proposed by the Financial Secretary Mr Paul Chan in the government's 2025-26 Budget.

Dr David Sun, Chairman of the AFRC remarked, "We fully support the Government's proposal to leverage the 'One Country, Two Systems' advantage to enhance integration into national development and proactive participation in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA). By upholding high quality audit standards and strengthening connectivity, the AFRC aims to foster a robust financial reporting and governance ecosystem that builds trust. This, in turn, enhances Hong Kong's position as a leading international financial centre, attracting investors and bolstering business growth."

In line with the Government's programme to reinforce fiscal consolidation, the AFRC will enforce strict budget controls and focus its resources on efficiency and sustainability to deliver effective regulatory outcomes.
