

Press Release 13 November 2018

Completed investigation

On 8 November 2018, the FRC adopted the investigation report on the audit of the consolidated financial statements of a listed entity for the year ended 30 June 2014.

The FRC found that the auditor, the engagement director and the engagement quality control reviewer failed or neglected to observe, maintain or otherwise apply certain professional standards in the relevant audit concerning (i) the accounting treatment of a convertible bond on issuance; and (ii) the genuineness and accuracy of the convertible bonds issuance cost.

In particular, it was found that:

- (a) the auditor and the engagement director were in breach of Hong Kong Standard on Auditing (**HKSA**) 200 Objective and General Principles Governing an Audit of Financial Statements, HKSA 330 The Auditor's Responses to Assessed Risks and HKSA 500 Audit Evidence.
- (b) the engagement quality control reviewer was in breach of HKSA 220 (Clarified) *Quality Control for an Audit of Financial Statements*.

The investigation report has been referred to the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants to determine if any disciplinary actions are warranted. Names of the relevant parties are withheld because of the potential disciplinary proceedings.
