After the Investigation and Compliance Department (**IC Department**) reviewed the complaints by reference to the materials provided by the respective complainants and the additional information obtained from the parties concerned, it considered that the complaints had no merit or the parties concerned had provided a satisfactory explanation to support that there was no auditing or reporting irregularities, misconducts or non-compliance with accounting requirements.
- 2. Includes cases that were referred directly to specified enforcement agencies because either the IC Department identified potential issues not within the remit of the AFRC or cases where auditing/reporting irregularities or misconducts were identified and the AFRC decided not to initiate an investigation. According to the AFRC Ordinance, "specified enforcement agency" means the Commissioner of Police of Hong Kong, the Commissioner of the Independent Commission Against Corruption, the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants, the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited, the Securities and Futures Commission, the Registrar of Companies, the Monetary Authority, the Insurance Authority, the Commissioner of Inland Revenue, the Official Receiver, the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority, or the Market Misconduct Tribunal.
